## WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

### Literacy:

**Reading** – Readers will account stories including character actions and how they contribute to the sequence. They will also recount stories using text-based details to understand the central message, lesson, or theme.

**Word Study** – The students will continue to practice various spelling patterns each week in class.

Grammar - Daily Language - Variety of writing skills,

mechanics, and conventions are practiced daily.

**Writing** – Writers will support a point of view with reasons and evidence.

#### Math:

The students will begin Chapter 12 – Geometry: Two-Dimensional Shapes. The mathematical concepts that are covered during this unit are plane shapes, angles in plane shapes, polygons, triangles, and quadrilaterals.

#### Social Studies:

The students will continue studying Brazil this month. We will study how culture, history, geography, people, and government affect communities in Brazil.

#### Science:

This month the students will be answering the question: What is an organism?

They are also learning music staff decoding skills with both note names and rhythms. Ms. Hession's class is learning how to read the music staff through folk songs in their textbook "The Music Connection", as well as using interactive smart board note reading games. They are working on folk songs from around the world throughout the year.

<u>Ms. LaMorte:</u> Students will work on improvisation on Orff Barred Instruments with proper mallet technique, read/apply Duple meter rhythms, and begin study of recorder.
