WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

Reading - We will be continuing our Nonfiction Workshop. Students will continue to read and respond to various expository nonfiction texts.

*Please remember to provide your child with ample nonfiction articles, books, etc. so that they may practice the skills learned in class at home.

Word Study - We are continuing to practice spelling patterns in the classroom. We are also continuing to use our Word a Day Program to build our vocabulary. We have also implemented a content-based vocabulary program to reinforce our skills in the areas of Social Studies and Mathematics.

Writing Workshop - Students are researching a nonfiction topic that they selected in class. They are organizing the information they find in their nonfiction book into categories that will help them begin drafting their feature articles.

*Please allow your child to use the internet in order to research additional articles related to their topic, as this will help them during the writing process..

Math:

This month students will study concepts in Unit Four, which will focus on decimals and their uses, as well as metric units of length. Some of the skills we will address are decimal place value, comparing and ordering decimals, estimating with decimals, decimal addition and subtraction, and using decimals to convert metric units of length. *Tip: Although Unit Three is complete, please continue to study the multiplication times tables nightly with your child, as students will need instant recall of these facts for future use.

Social Studies:

We will continue Three Worlds Meet. Chapter 3 will be completed this month. The main focuses of Chapter 3 are the first explorers and the development of colonies. We will take a close look at life in the Dutch colony of New Amsterdam. We will also examine life in New York colony under English rule.


Science:
