- 1. The contest is **<u>open to ALL</u>** students graduating in **2018**; it is **<u>NOT limited to art students</u>**.
- 2. The <u>theme</u>, "What power is within you", <u>must be expressed in the artwork</u> and follow the criteria indicated on the flyer.
- 3. Entries <u>must be Color on white paper, no larger than 8 ½" x 11"</u>, suitable for the cover of the Scholarship Luncheon Journal.
- 4. <u>Excessive shading, pointillism, complicated figures and light entries do not reproduce well and should be avoided.</u>
- 5. All entries <u>must be original artwork</u>. <u>No photocopies</u> of original artwork <u>or computer generated</u> artwork will be accepted. Religious symbols must <u>not</u> be included in the artwork and will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.
- 6. <u>All entries must be labeled on the back</u> with the student's name, school, grade, homeroom, home address and telephone number. <u>No names should appear on the front</u> of the artwork.
- 7. Any submissions that do not follow directions will be disqualified.
- 8. All entries <u>must be submitted</u> to the College Office, Parent Coordinator, or School Designee by <u>February 27, 2018</u>.
- 9. Art Contest <u>recipient must be present to accept the award on Tuesday, June 5, 2018</u> at the Scholarship Luncheon, held at the Hilton Garden Inn, 1100 South Avenue, Staten Island, NY.

The PTA President will <u>pick up</u> the submitted artwork <u>by March 9th</u> from the College Office, Parent Coordinator or School Designee. The PTA President will <u>deliver</u> the artwork to the Staten Island Federation of PTAs' Scholarship Committee <u>by Wednesday, March 14th.</u>

Federation Executive Board members will judge the entries. The winning entry will be selected on the basis of artistic quality, originality within the confines of the theme, and the ease that the artwork can be reproduced.
