What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – Students will begin reading the realistic fiction novel, *Maniac Magee* by Jerry Spinelli. We will continue to focus on quoting accurately from a text while supporting our theories as readers. Daily Language Activities will be utilized to improve our writing skills. Students will begin to brainstorm ideas for persuasive writing pieces.

Math – The students will understand that fractions represent division. They will also learn to multiply fractions and whole numbers, estimate products, multiply two fractions, use area models, solve multi-step problems, and divide whole numbers by fractions and unit fractions by whole numbers.

Science - We won the SMART KIDS: ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM grant from Con Edison! Our fifth grade scientists will be learning about and experimenting with ENERGY this month and discovering how they can conserve energy in their everyday lives.

Social Studies – The students will read *Hudson* by Janice Weaver to examine the difficulties Hudson had to face in each of his voyages. Students will identify the impact his voyage had on the European and North American continents and decide how history should remember Hudson.
