What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – Students will continue to read the novel, "The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane." Our focus remains on analyzing characters and using text evidence to support our theories. A 2 point short response rubric is utilized to improve our writing about reading. Students will publish a narrative.

Math – Students will use mental strategies and standard algorithm for multi-digit whole numbers multiplication, decimal multiplication, and measurement word problems. Students will also use mental strategies and partial quotients in multi-digit whole number and decimal division and solve word problems.

Science – Students enter the VARIABLES UNIT where they work through the STEPS of the SCIENTIFIC METHOD to identify, classify and analyze the relationship between Independent and Dependent Variables. In class experiments will be conducted using pendulums and buoyancy.

Social Studies - Students will identify the differences between a primary and secondary source. Students will then examine how archaeology helps shape our understanding of prehistoric humans and early man.
