What topics will the students learn this month?

ELA – During April the students will begin to write a narrative writing piece where they will produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization and style are related to the task.

Math – Our 5th grade students will finish up their fractions unit by learning to multiply and divide fractions and mixed numbers. We will then begin working on solids and volume. Our 6th graders will begin April with measuring angles and finish with an introduction to ratios.

Science – This month the students will define Science and identify questions that Science cannot answer. The students will also identify the three branches of Science. The students will define hypothesis and recognize the difference between observation and inference.

Social Studies – We will begin our unit on American History this month. We will be starting with the Colonist and the road from Colonies to a Nation.
