## What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – During the month of April we will be beginning our next novel. This is a nonfiction piece of literature. We will focus on standards annotating and vocabulary standards as students will need to use context clues to determine meanings of unfamiliar terms.

Math – This month we will move into our unit on solids and volume. We will also be reviewing all our topics learned throughout the year in preparation for the upcoming NY State Math exam on May  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$ .

Science – The students will define what Science is and identify questions that Science cannot answer. They will compare and contrast theories and law. The student will identify the three branches of Science. They will define hypothesis and recognize how the scientific method is applied as well as, identify the difference between observation and inference.

Social Studies – During the month of April the students will be learning about World War I.
