What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – During the month of December we will begin reading our next novel *Wonder* by Raquel J. Palacio. We will focus on gathering evidence to understand the theme of the text.

Math – In December we will continue our number sense topic focusing on long division with 1 and 2 digit divisors in 5th grade. Our 6th graders shift their focus slightly to look more deeply at operations with fractions.

Science – This month the students will recognize that matter is made up of particles in constant motion. The students will relate the three states of matter to the arrangement of particles within them. Students will relate changes in thermal energy to changes of state.

Social Studies – During this month we will continue the study of Henry Hudson and develop our own opinion.
