#### What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – This month we will finish our novel *Because of Winn Dixie* by Kate DiCamillo and continue to review and practice our standards including looking deeply at how we can compare characters and how a character changes throughout a novel.

Math – During the month of December the students will focus on long division with and without using a variety of strategies.

Science – Students will identify gases in earth's atmosphere and describe the structure of earth's atmosphere. Students will recognize the importance of the earth's atmosphere and how the layers impact life on earth. Students will describe what happens to the energy earth receives from the sun, comparing and contrasting radiation, conduction and convention.

Social Studies – During this month the students will learn about Ancient Rome. They will work on writing extended responses to social studies based questions
