What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – The students are expected to complete our realistic fiction novel *Esperanza Rising* by Pam Muñoz Ryan this month. They are beginning to see how a character changes and evolves throughout a novel. We will continue to focus on the grade level standards in this text as well as other fiction and nonfiction pieces of work as we prepare ourselves for our upcoming NYS English Language Arts exam.

Math – We will be finishing up our work with fractions in early March. It is important that students master simplifying and know all four operations with fractions. Our next topic will be on solids and volumes.

Science – Students will explain how tornadoes develop from thunderstorms and discuss the dangers of severe weather. The students will also explain how data is collected for weather maps and forecasts and identify symbols used in weather maps.

Social Studies – During the Month of March the students will be learning all about the French Revolution.
