# What topics will the students learn this month?



ELA – The students will continue working on their narrative writing piece during the month of May

Math – During May our sixth grade curriculum will look at equations with more than one operation as well as statistical data. In fifth grade, the students will focus on classifying quadrilaterals and finding distances on a coordinate plane.

Science – The students will identify how plants and animals in an ecosystem are connected. They will describe how plants and animals depend on each other and their physical environment. The students will also analyze how human decisions and activities have a profound impact on the physical and living environment.
