What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – In May we will be finishing *Esperanza Rising* and will begin our nonfiction unit. We will start reading our next book, a biography of Jackie Robinson. The students will analyze the text for the relationships between two or more individuals, events or concepts based on information from the text.

Math – During the month of May the students will continue to work on standards based Math concepts including measurement and data.

Science – Students will identify places where life is found on Earth. Students will define ecology. Students will observe how the environment influences life and list factors that influence changes in population size. Students will describe how organisms obtain energy for life. Students will identify how organisms interact and will recognize that every organism occupies a niche.

Social Studies – During the month of May the students will be learning about World War I.


