# What topics will the students learn this month?



ELA – In April we will continue to research articles and various texts to understand multiple perspectives surrounding an event. The students will use all available resources to research and write their own informational article in a newspaper format.

Math – The students will be reviewing all topics covered throughout the year. Such topics include The Number System, Expressions and Equations, Geometry, and Ratios & Proportional Relationships.

Science – The students in class 620 will explain what energy is and be able to distinguish between kinetic and potential energy. The students will identify various forms of energy.
