What topics will the students learn today?



ELA – In December we will be finishing our novel, *Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief*. We will also be finishing our Narrative on character traits. We will begin a short unit on poetry during this month, before a larger unit on non-fiction texts.

Math – Sixth graders will be working on expressions and equations. They will be solving an equation that involves finding the value of the unknown that makes the equation true. There is more than one way to solve an equation.

Science – For the month of December the students will begin learning about the Earth's atmosphere and characteristics that make up each layer of Earth's atmosphere. They will learn about atmospheric pressure, the ozone layer, reasons the ozone layer is being destroyed, and steps that have been taken to reduce destruction to the ozone layer.

Social Studies – Students will identify and define the main characteristics of the Paleolithic Era and Neolithic Era and then be able to describe the Neolithic Revolution as a pivotal turning point in human history. Students will analyze and explain the effects of the Neolithic Revolution on the human race.
