## What topics will the students learn today?



ELA – Our next unit will incorporate test prep into understanding perspectives. We will investigate newspaper articles and research multiple perspectives on the same event in order to understand how diverse points of view help us live in an increasingly diverse society. We will also learn multiple strategies for constructing short responses and demystifying multiple choice - all according to the NYS Evaluation Rubric.

Math – This month the students will be able to classify polyhedrons and identify vertices, edges and faces; identify a polyhedron from its net and draw top, side and front views.

Science – This month the students in class 620 will explore scientific texts to be able to cite text evidence to support their analysis. The students will determine the central idea and provide a detailed summary of a text. These skills will guide students for test prep of the NY State ELA exam in April. The students will also work on an evidence claim essay using these skills. The students in class 621 and 622 will continue to learn about biotic and abiotic factors in environments. This unit includes how climate influences life in an ecosystem, the different levels of energy in a food chain and how organisms that live in parts of the ocean where sunlight does not reach, use chemosynthesis to produce their own energy rich molecules.

Social Studies –During the month of March the students will be reading and analyzing Data Based Questions (DBQs) to learn all about the European Monarchy.
