### What topics will the students learn this month?



ELA – Continuing to research as writers, we will use our newly donated Chromebooks to gather information about the 1906 Earthquake and Fire. How does investigating multiple perspectives surrounding the same event, shape our point of view? We will become journalists and publish our own newspaper articles.

Math – Chapter 19 we will be working on statistics and probability. The students will learn that different measures can be used to describe the center of a numerical data set. Each measure is most appropriate depending on characteristics of the data.

Science – During this month the students in class 620 will design controlled experiments and identify independent, dependent and constant variables used in an experiment. The students will also describe the procedure used. Students in Class 621 & 622 will apply mathematics equations to describe relationships among variables in the natural world. They will recognize when "work" is being done, and they will use mathematical equations to calculate work, power, mechanical advantage, efficiency, etc. They will also learn how machines make work easier and how friction influences efficiency.

Social Studies – This month the student will study European Monarchs.
