I want to thank the eighth grade parents for attending our informational Sip & Share with Ms. Buckheit and Mr. Tabbitas. I am in the process of distributing High School applications to our eighth grade students. We are discussing what Petrides High School has to offer and I am arranging a "High School Shadowing" experience for students during the month of November. High School applications are due back to my office on or before December 1, 2017. Please remember that if Petrides is not listed as your number one choice for public schools, you may lose your seat in our high school program.

We are excited to expand our social/emotional learning opportunities by partnering with the YMCA Counseling Service Branch. Our 7th grade students will be participating in the Second Step Program. The students will learn about empathy, communication, bullying prevention, emotional management and substance abuse prevention.

Our PAL after school program is well underway. I am excited to see so many students in attendance! We are offering Cooking, Boy's Rap, Basketball (Boys Varsity, Boys Junior Varsity, Girls), Spin Class, Flag Football, Floor Hockey, Girl's Talk, Step, Drum Line, Robotics, National Junior Honor Society (civics and service), test prep and homework help. In order for students to participate, they must complete a PAL application. Applications are available online at petridesschool.com or in my office. The program runs from 2:20 to 6:00 daily and students can attend only part time if desired.

ELA – Students will begin reading *The Lightening Thief* by author Rick Riordan and begin to compare themes across literature such as: Family, Friendship, Perseverance and Facing Challenges. August (*Wonder*) and Percy (*Lightening Thief*) both struggle with challenges in their lives. They will examine themes that connect to both characters. The students will also work on a narrative writing piece that focuses on a hero in the everyday world.

Math – During the month of November students will continue working on the number system topic. They will learn to find the quotients of divisions involving mixed numbers. In addition the students will be able to graph points on a coordinate plane.

Science – This month the students in class 620 will be recognizing that matter is made of particles in constant motion. They will also relate the three states of matter to the arrangement of particles within them. The students will then relate changes in thermal energy to change of state. The students in class 621 & 622 will begin to study the atmosphere that surrounds our planet and makes life here possible. They will learn about gases that make up our atmosphere and how the atmosphere is broken up into layers that all have their own properties.

Social Studies – The students will learn how to write a Social Studies essay during this month. They will be drafting the essay in class.
