What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – This month the students will read the novel *Wonder* by RJ Palacio and make inferences about character point of view. They will connect the novel to themes across literature (6.RL.2) using *The Lightning Thief* as a comparative text. The students will also analyze comparative statements detecting themes such as Overcoming Obstacles, Perseverance, Fear of Failure, and Friendship. The students will then choose a theme to complete their Performance Task and write a narrative about an Everyday Hero. They will use their Voice to peer assess and share their writing.

Math – Students will be working on chapter on 9 and 10 throughout this month. They will be able to interpret and compute quotients of fractions, and solve word problems involving division of fraction models and equations to represent the problem. The students will also be able to understand that positive and negative numbers are used together to describe quantities that have opposite directions or values.

Science – This month the students will continue to recognize that the motion of particles help to explain the phases of matter as well as changes from one phase to another. They will define and comprehend thermal energy and temperature. They will also relate changes in thermal energy to changes of state.

Social Studies – Students will examine how archaeology helps shape our understanding of prehistoric humans and early man. Students will identify the elements of a civilization. Students will also identify the differences between a primary and secondary source.
