### What topics will the students learn today?



ELA – During the month of March the students will learn how to write persuasive essays in connection with themes discussed in *Lyddie*. We will also continue practicing test taking strategies for the upcoming NY State ELA exam.

Math – This month the students will investigate chance processes and develop, use and evaluate probability models. They will find probabilities of compound events using organized lists, tables, tree diagrams and simulation.

Science – This month the students will learn how volcanoes form, different types of volcanoes and what determines how a volcano erupts. They will continue to make connections between heat flow and movement within Earth and sections of Earth's crust moving. When this unit is complete, the students will move from the branch of Earth Science to the branch of Life Science.

Social Studies - This month our Social Studies Scholars will be exploring the presidencies of our first 3 Presidents and starting Unit 4: A Nation Grows – Expansion and Reform 1800 - 1860. We will also be conducting a mini-unit in preparation for the 2018 ELA State Exam focused on Non-Fiction Reading/Writing. March 9th will be our annual Middle School Social Studies Fair! This year's theme is "Issues of Power, Race, and Gender". Be on the lookout for information regarding our spring trip to Philadelphia!
