What topics will the students learn this month?

ELA – In May we will continue learning about the author's use of symbolism in *Speak*. The students will analyze how symbolism contributes to the novel's theme. We will meet in small groups every Friday to discuss student-selected novels. The students will then prepare for and participate in literature circles.

Math – The students will graph proportional relationships, interpreting the unit rate as the slope of the graph. They will also compare two different proportional relationships represented in different ways.

Science – For the month of May, the students will learn about invertebrate animals. They will discover how living things are classified by shared characteristics on the cellular and organism level. They will also learn how plants and animals have a great variety of body parts and internal structures that contribute to their ability to maintain a balanced condition.

Social Studies – This month our Social Studies Scholars will be completing their study of Unit 4: A Nation Grows, Expansion and Reform 1800-1860 with a study of the Industrial Revolution, Erie Canal, Gold Rush, Irish potato Famine, and Declaration of Sentiments. We will then begin Unit 5: A Nation Divided, which will take us through the growth of slavery, abolition movement, and causes/effects of the Civil War. We will conclude our year in mid-June with a U.S. History/Government Mock Regents focused exclusively on the material studied this year as well as an independent research project.


