The New York State Math Assessment is scheduled for Tuesday, May 1, 2018 and Wednesday, May 2, 2018.

The end of the third marking period is April 12, 2018.

I am very pleased with the number of students who chose to become members of our National Junior Honor Society. Students will be notified of their acceptance on April 20, 2018. Our ceremony will be held in May. The date will be forthcoming.

Preparations for end of year ceremonies and celebrations are well underway. The eighth grade end of year letter outlining dates and costs is attached to this newsletter. What topics will the students learn this month?

ELA – This month the students will begin the novel *Speak* by Laurie Halse Anderson. They will also continue to learn and work on gathering information and organizing ideas to form a coherent expository writing piece.

Math – During the month of April the Grade 7 students will review all the skills learned this year in preparation for the upcoming NY State Math exam on May 1^{st} and 2^{nd} . The students in Grade 8 will continue to factor expressions using GCF, the Difference of Perfect Squares and Trinomials. Also, the graphing calculators will be used to help us graph functions more effectively.

Science – The students will begin their journey through the human body. They will identify the major organ system in the body and describe how each organ works. They will describe various disorders and diseases associated with each system. They will also discuss how disease is a failure to maintain homeostasis.

Social Studies – During the month of April the student will be learning all about Vietnam and the Nixon presidency. We will be using Data Based Questions (DB's), videos and various articles to better understand that period in American History.
