A Note from our PTA:

Please join us for Family Bowling on March 25, 2018 at Showplace Bowling Center from 1:00 – 3:00pm. The cost is \$15 per person. There will be two games of bowling, pizza, raffles and a bake sale.



What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – During the month of March we will focus on preparing for the NY State ELA exam. Our curriculum will focus on reading and annotating a text along with answering multiple choice questions, short responses and writing an essay based on short stories.

Math – This month the students in grade 7 will use measures of central tendency and measures of variability of numerical data from random samples to draw informational comparative inferences about 2 populations. The students in grade 8 will learn how to graph quadratic equations and factor expressions in different ways.

Science – The students will continue their study of genetics and begin their study of evolution in the month of March. They will perform a laboratory experiment encompassing all the material learned in chapter 13 and 14. They will describe how scientists modify DNA, analyze DNA and use it in solving crimes. They will then apply their knowledge of DNA to the mechanisms of evolution.

Social Studies – During the month of March the students will be learning all about post World War II United states. They will also study Data Based Questions (DBQs) to learn about the Cold War.
