## What topics will the students learn this month?

ELA – During the month of May the students will continue the novel *Speak* by Laurie Halse Anderson. They will also complete their argumentative writing piece.

Math – This month our seventh graders will graph proportional relationships, interpreting the unit rate as the slope of the graph. They will also compare two different proportional relationships represented in different ways. The eighth graders will continue to review topics for the Algebra I Regents exam on June 12<sup>th</sup>. They will also begin to take practice regents exams.

Science – The students will continue their study of human anatomy and physiology. They will identify how the immune system protects them from disease and how disease is a failure to maintain homeostasis. They will also identify and describe the parts and function of the reproductive systems of males and females. The students will explain how the menstrual cycle prepares the body for pregnancy.

Social Studies – During the month of May we will be working on US History Regents review.


