#### What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – Students will continue to explore Edgar Allan Poe's writings- *The Tell Tale Heart, The Raven, and Annabel Lee.* During this unit, they will analyze poetic devices, figurative language, mood, central idea, and how an author's life shapes their writing. We will also learn how to write a literary essay as a culminating task for this unit.

Math – We will expand upon linear equations by observing systems of equations. We will learn to solve system of equations both algebraically and graphically while checking our work on our graphing calculators.

Science – Students will continue their study of Homeostasis in the human body. They will identify the major human anatomical structures belonging to each of our organ systems. They will describe how the systems work separately and with other systems to maintain homeostasis within the body. They will also research some diseases of each system to understand how it is a failure of homeostasis.

Social Studies – This month the students will study Progressive Era/WWI and the effects of the United States.
