What topics will the students learn today?



ELA – During the month of February we will finish *Of Mice and Men* by analyzing multiple themes found throughout the book. The students will learn how to write a thematic essay using MLA format.

Math – We just finished learning about different statistics topics such as box plots, histogram and correlation coefficients. We will now begin to explore arithmetic/geometric sequences.

Science – The students will continue their study of genetics in February. They will describe the structure of DNA and how its message is carried to the ribosome for protein synthesis. They will identify reasons for genetic disorders through the study of various types of mutations. They will learn how to read a DNA fingerprint and explain how DNA is used in the study of Forensics.

Social Studies – The students will understand how our country was reconstructed after the Civil War. They will learn about the addition of the fourteenth, fifteenth, and sixteenth amendments to the constitution. The students will also learn about the post Civil War south and the start of the technological revolution.
