What topics will the students learn today?



ELA –During the month of March we will focus on preparing for the NY State ELA exam. Our curriculum will focus on reading and annotating a text for the test along with answering multiple choice questions, short responses, and an essay for paired passages.

Math – We are currently learning how to identify the domain and range of functions, in particular quadratic functions. We will next explore how to graph and identify absolute value functions. The graphing calculator will be used as a tool to help us graph the functions on graph paper more effectively.

Science – The students will complete their study of genetics and begin their study of evolution in the month of March. They will perform a laboratory experiment encompassing all the material learned in chapter 13 and 14. They will describe how scientists modify DNA, analyze DNA and use it in solving crimes. They will then apply their knowledge of DNA to the mechanisms of evolution.

Social Studies – The students will understand life during the Gilded Age. They will learn how muckrakers will expose the ills of society. They will also learn how imperialism will fuel our
