What topics will the students learn this month?

ELA – Students will be preparing for the NYS ELA Exam by critically thinking about nonfiction and fictional reading passages while annotating and answering comprehension questions. During this month, students will also be participating in book clubs by reading books based on events during the Holocaust. Students are expected to independently read, take notes, and participate within their small groups.

Math – We just finished mastering how to find the correlation coefficient and linear regression of data values. We will now be exploring exponential functions and analyzing the growth and decay of graphs and tables of values.

Science – Students will continue their study of genetics for the month of March. They will investigate how mutations affect the DNA sequence and subsequent proteins. They will research genetic disease and debate whether GMA foods are safe to eat.

Social Studies – During the month of March the students will be learning about Post World War II America and the Cold War.
