What topics will the students learn today?

ELA – During this month, students will read multiple articles on the topic of "The Debate over Making Friends on the Internet." After students read the articles, they will take a precise position regarding the topic of internet friendships. Their final assignment will be to write an argumentative essay including a strong claim, evidence, and a counterclaim.

Math – We will be finishing up the Algebra 1 curriculum and begin to review for the Regents. We will go over all the topics again briefly from the beginning of the year and practice sample Regents questions and also take practice Regents exams in class.

Science –This month the students will identify parts of a food chain and distinguish between a food chain and a food web. They will analyze graphs to illustrate how limiting factors affect a population's growth. They will discuss how abiotic factors affect the carrying capacity of a species.

Social Studies –During the month of May the students will learn about Watergate, and Presidents Reagan, H.W. Bush, Clinton and W. Bush. Then it's all Regents Review in preparation for the US History Regents Exam.
