Directions: Fill in the following boxes in the chart with quotes from your novel of choice and inferences based on your unique thinking.

Step #1: Start reading your novel. While reading, select quotes that stand out to you as being **important**. Use the **analysis section** to help frame your thinking and quote selection.

Step #2: When you find an important quote, **stop, write down the page # and the direct quote** that you want to analyze in columns 1 and 2 in our graphic organizer. Be sure to place quotation marks and punctuation in the quote that you choose.

Step #3: You should answer **at least one or two** of the analysis questions in the third column to explain why you selected this quote. Include **thoughtful comments, connections, reactions, inferences, predictions**, etc.
