## WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

#### <u>Literacy:</u>

**Word Study** – In June, we will study diphthongs, suffixes, prefixes, and homographs.

**Reading Workshop-** In June, we will be conducting author studies. Students will read multiple books by the same author, comparing and contrasting the different stories.

Writers understand valid opinions are supported by reasons.

\*Please continue to read daily with your child - encourage him/her to use print strategies to figure out difficult words, retell the story in sequence (beginning, middle, end). Encourage them to ask questions and then discuss possible responses to their questions.

**Writing Workshop-** students will formulate an opinion and support it with good reasons.

#### Math:

Unit 12 – Reasoning about attributes of, and composing and decomposing geometric shapes.

Domain: Geometry

#### Technology:

Your child will continue practicing their keyboarding and mouse skills, typing, resources used for research, and proper use of the Internet. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. In the month of June we will be focusing primarily on mouse and keyboarding skills.



## What's New in Music and Art?

Ms. LaMorte: Students will learn 5 dances, identify/apply lines and spaces of music staff, and discuss/apply leadership in a group activity.

Ms. Eliot: Students will revisit some favorite songs to review rhythms and movements with music.
