WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

Mentor Text: Earth Dragon Awakes

Lessons will focus on the following Common Core Literacy Standards:

RL 2.1 - Ask and answer questions

RL 2.3 - How characters respond to major events

RL 2.4 – How words and phrases give meaning in a story RL 2.5 – Describe beginning, middle, and end of a story

Writing: Narrative Writing - W 2.3

Students are expected to write a sequence of events, including details, thoughts and feelings.

Word Study: Students will be working on consonant patterns, vowel patterns, and inflected endings.

Grammar: Students will be working on adverbs.

Math: Go Math Chapter 8

Students will be able to:

- Measure and estimate lengths in standard units.
- Relate addition and subtraction to length.
- Represent and interpret data.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Students will continue to learn about 'New York City over time'.

<u>Science</u>: Students will learn about rocks and soil and how they are related.





Technology: Your child will continue practicing their keyboarding and mouse skills, typing, resources used for research, and proper use of the Internet. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed.
