WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

- Mentor Texts: Folk Tales
- Beauty and the Beast
 - Little Red Riding Hood
 - Lon Po Po

Lessons will focus on the following Common Core Literacy Standards:

- RL 2.5 – Describe the overall structure of the text.
RL 2.2 – I can recount stories, including folktales from diverse cultures, and determine their central message, lesson or moral.
RL 2.7 – I can use information gained from illustrations and words in print to demonstrate understanding of its characters, setting, or plot.
RL 2.9 – I can compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story by different authors or from different cultures.

Writing: Narrative Writing Unit

Phonics: This month we will be working on plurals and vowel patterns.

Grammar: Irregular verbs, commas, apostrophes

Math: Go Math Chapter 4 – 2-Digit Addition

This month students will:

- Break apart addends as tens and ones
- Model and record 2-digit addition
- Regroup for addition
- Problem solve
- Write equations to represent addition
- Find sums for 3 & 4 addends

Social Studies: Our Community’s Geography
 How does geography influence where people choose to live?

Technology:

During the month of December, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed.

What’s New in Music and Art?

Mr. Cintula: We are moving forward from our songs of thankfulness and into our winter pieces in our Music Connection text. Upcoming pieces will focus on rhythm patterns and dynamics.

Ms. LaMorte (Class 332): Students will analyze music (major/Minor; Duple), learn new dance activity, learn/apply Rondo form in song with rhythm instruments and dance, learn 8 songs with motions, and self-evaluate.

Ms. Eliot: Students will revisit some favorite songs to review rhythms and movements with music.
