WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

English Language Arts:

In February, students will continue to read fictional stories. We will be practicing summarizing portions of a text, retelling important ideas, and identifying the central message. We will also use supporting standards to practice analyzing how characters respond to major challenges, identifying words and phrases that appeal to the senses and suggest feelings, and 'reading' illustrations.

Word Work:

February's word skills include:

- y as e or i
- open syllables for one and two syllable words
- suffices y, ly and ty
- r controlled words

Writing:

This month's writing goals are for students to write with clarity, be more descriptive and add examples to their work.

Math:

Module 4: Addition and Subtraction Within 200 with Word Problems to 100, continued

Adding and subtracting two- and three- digit numbers continues to be the emphasis. Students will freely choose which strategy best suits the problem at hand and check their work by using the standard vertical algorithm. Our goal is for students to master solving one- and two- step word problems.

Focus standards are:

2.OA.1 Use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve oneand two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing, with unknowns in all positions.

2.NBT.5 Fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value

2.NBT.6 Add using strategies based on place value and properties of operations.

2.NBT.7 Add and subtract within 1000, using concrete models or drawings and strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction; relate the strategy to a written method.

2.NBT.8 Mentally add 10 or 100 to a given number 100-900, and mentally subtract 10 or 100 from a given number 100-900.
2.NBT.9 Explain why addition and subtraction strategies work, using place value and the properties of operations. (Explanations may be supported by drawings or objects.)



Technology:

During the month of February, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed.

Science:

Earth Science will be this month's focus. Students will be learning about habitats with attention on what plants need and how plants depend on animals.

Social Studies:

Students will continue studying mapping skills and learn how to identify features of a map. Our goals are for students to be able to locate places using a map, create a map, and realize the importance of good directional skills.

What's New in Performing Arts?

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of *February* students will create their book designs.

Ms. LaGrotta (332): During dance class in February, second grade classes will be continuing identifying and demonstrating isolated dance moves of various body parts, locomotor and non-locomotor movements, and dancing with different tempos and rhythms.
