# WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

#### <u>Literacy:</u>

<u>Reading</u> – The students will be reading texts to distinguish their own point of view from the point of view of the narrator, author, or other characters in the text.

<u>Vocabulary</u> – Students will be using Wordly Wise in class. They will be assessed on their words each Friday.

Writing – The students will be writing opinion pieces on topics supporting their point of view with reasons.

#### Math:

We will continue to prepare the students for the Math Statewide Assessment. Using various materials, we will review all of the skills that the children will be exposed to on the upcoming exam.

#### Social Studies:

The students will continue to study China. We will study how culture, history, geography, people, and government affect communities in China.

#### <u>Technology:</u>

During the month of April, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.
