WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

<u>Reading</u> - The students will recount stories, including fables, folktales, and myths from diverse cultures. They will also be determining the central message, lesson, or moral and explain how it is conveyed through key details in the text.

<u>Vocabulary</u> - Each week the students will receive vocabulary words that relate to our unit of study. They will be assessed on those words each Friday.

Math:

The students will begin to work on Chapter 9, Compare Fractions. The students will learn how to compare fractions with same numerator and denominator, compare and order fractions, and identify and model equivalent fractions.

Social Studies:

The students will begin their journey through China and take a closer look at the history, culture, geography, and people of China.

Technology:

Your child will continue practicing their keyboarding and mouse skills, typing, resources used for research, and proper use of the Internet. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. In the month of February we will be focusing on typing skills. We will also be introduced to Microsoft Word and learning how to find information about a topic using online resources.



What's New in Music and Art?
