WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

<u>Literacy:</u>

<u>Reading</u> – The students will recount stories, including fables, folktales, and myths from diverse cultures. They will also be determining the central message, lesson, or moral and explain how it is conveyed through key details in the text.

<u>Writing</u> - Students will learn how to answer an extended response question.

Vocabulary – Students will be using Wordly Wise in class. They will be assessed on their words each Friday.

Math:

The students will continue to work on Chapter 11, finding and modeling perimeter and area.

<u>Social Studies:</u>

The students will begin their journey through China and take a closer look at the history, culture, geography, and people of China.

<u>Technology:</u>

During the month of February, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.
