WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

Reading -

The students will be identifying the main idea of a text and be able to support the main idea with key details from the text.

Writing - Students will continue writing their informational pieces on a topic of their choice.

Vocabulary - Students will be using Wordly Wise in class. They will be assessed on their words each Friday.

Math:

Students will begin Eureka Math Module 4 -Multiplication and Area. Students will learn about area using area models to help them understand the concepts of area measurement.

Social Studies:

The students will begin their journey through China and take a closer look at the history, culture, geography, and people of China.

Science:

The students will continue to learn about living organisms.

Technology:

During the month of January, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.



What's New in Performing Arts?

Mr. Cintula: 3rd Grade General Music is beginning the new year with Unit 1: Music for the Fun of It! Which incorporates singing, moving, analyzing and introduction to Orff instruments. Ms. Eliot: Students will learn about the different instruments in an orchestra and explore the elements of music.

Ms. Granatelli: Happy New Year! During the month of January 2020 students begin their Visual Arts Component. Students start with learning about the elements of designs.
