WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

Reading – Readers will read informative texts to develop opinions about current issues. They will discuss their point of view and the author's point of view during Socratic Seminar.

<u>Vocabulary</u> - Each week the students will receive vocabulary words that relate to our unit of study. They will be assessed on those words each Friday.

<u>Writing</u> – Our 3rd grade writers will identify their point of view on a topic and write an opinion piece.

Math:

The students will review all math skills learned throughout the year: multiplication, division, fractions, area, perimeter, and multistep word problems.

Social Studies:

The students will continue studying Italy this month. We will study how culture, history, geography, people, and government affect communities in Italy.

Technology:

Your child will continue practicing their keyboarding and mouse skills, typing, resources used for research, and proper use of the Internet. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. In the month of June we will be focusing on typing skills. We will also be introduced to Microsoft Word and learning how to find information about a topic using online resources.

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What's New in Music and Art?

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of June students will be learning about working with modeling clay.

Mr. Cintula: We are continuing to work on folk music from around the world in our 3rd grade level book and are learning basic keyboard skills. Also, we are exploring basic percussion section accompaniment to our repertoire of textbook songs.

Ms. LaMorte: Students will secure recorder notes B and A, learn new note G on recorder, learn new recorder piece for notes B, A, and G, work in 3 groups with new combinable piece for Harmonic Concepts, learn 2 dances, identify/apply lines and spaces of music staff, and keep steady beat in Duple rhythm activity in 2 groups.
