WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

<u>Literacy:</u>

<u>Reading</u> – Students will distinguish their own Point of View (POV) from that of the author of a text using non-fiction articles. <u>Vocabulary</u> – Students will be using Wordly Wise in class. They will be assessed on their words each Friday. <u>Writing</u> – Students will write opinion pieces on topics supporting

a POV with reasons,

<u>Math:</u>

The students will begin Chapter 12 – Geometry: Two-Dimensional Shapes. The mathematical concepts that are covered during this unit are plane shapes, angles in plane shapes, polygons, triangles, and quadrilaterals.

Social Studies:

The students will begin studying Brazil. We will study how culture, history, geography, people, and government affect communities in Brazil.

<u>Science:</u>

The students will be learning about weather this month.

<u>Technology:</u>

During the month of May, your child will be focusing their navigation skills using their prior practice of keyboarding and mouse expertise, along with proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.

What's New in Music and Art?
