WHAT ARE WE STUDYING? Literacy:

Students will be analyzing persuasive texts and developing opinion writing based on the pros and cons surrounding the issue. Students will be using text evidence to support their interpretation on the discussion topic.

Math:

Unit 7 will focus on developing our understanding of fraction equivalence, addition and subtraction of fractions with like denominators and multiplication of fractions by whole numbers. Students will be working on using models and multiplication to generate equivalent fractions. We will also be working on writing fractions in their simplest form. The unit will also include comparing fractions by first writing them as fractions with a common numerator or denominator.

Social Studies:

We are beginning to discuss the reasons behind the American Revolution. Students have been learning about the beginning of the thirteen colonies, England's control over the colonies, and the start of the Revolution.

Science

Students will be learning about electricity, magnets, conductors and insulators.

What's New in Music and Art?

Mr. Cintula: This current rotation is beginning their study of folk music from around the world in each grade level book. Both classes are also exploring music about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and civil rights.

Ms. LaMorte: Students will study Soprano Recorder, learn note E with new piece of music and coordinate with familiar notes B, A, G, possibly learn note D and begin new piece), and self-evaluate.

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of February students continue working on their self-portrait.
