WHAT ARE WE STUDYING? Literacy:

Students will be analyzing persuasive texts and developing opinion writing based on the pros and cons surrounding the issue. Students will be using text evidence to support their interpretation on the discussion topic.

Math:

Unit 7 will focus on developing our understanding of fraction equivalence, addition and subtraction of fractions with like denominators and multiplication of fractions by whole numbers. Students will be working on using models and multiplication to generate equivalent fractions. We will also be working on writing fractions in their simplest form. The unit will also include comparing fractions by first writing them as fractions with a common numerator or denominator.

Social Studies:

We are beginning to discuss the reasons behind the American Revolution. Students have been learning about the beginning of the thirteen colonies, England's control over the colonies, and the start of the Revolution.

Science

This month the curriculum will include simple machines and forces of motion. Students will begin preparing in class for the upcoming state test. Vocabulary is a very big part of the science test. We encourage you to continue to review vocabulary by making flash cards.

What's New in Music and Art?

Mr. Cintula: We are beginning the song "This is Me" (from The Greatest Showman). We are working on following our voice section in this two part arrangement. The students are getting prepared to see and follow multiple parts in their fifth grade music next year.

Ms. LaMorte: Students will begin study of Soprano Recorder with securing familiar notes B, A and G, learn new piece with new note Low E and possibly new note Low D with new piece.

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of February, students will explore creating collages. They will also continue learning about and exploring the "Elements of Design".



Technology:

During the month of February, your child will be focusing on both keyboarding and mouse skills, as well as proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools and a Typing Software Program to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.
