WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Literacy:

We are beginning test preparation for the upcoming NYS examination. Students will be working in class and at home in their Common Core aligned Test Ready booklets and ELA packets. We will be reviewing test strategies, rubrics, and writing responses to select prompts.

Math:

We will be moving into Chapter 8 of the Go Math program. Students will learn to write fractions as the products of a whole number and a unit fraction. They will use models and diagrams to multiply a fraction by a whole number.

We will continue to prepare for the upcoming state Math tests. We will continue to learn strategies to solve word problems. Also, we are working on building strong explanations to support mathematical thinking.

Social Studies:

Unit 3 will examine the effects of the American Revolution on the people of New York. The students will learn about Colonists' response to British rule. We will also learn about the role New York played in the Revolution.

Science:

Students will be learning about simple machines this month.

What's New in Music and Art?

Mr. Cintula: We are continuing to work on folk music from around the world in our 4th grade level book. We are also wrapping up our work of music about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and civil rights.

Ms. LaMorte: Students will work on Recorder with new notes Low D and High C with 2 music selections, and learn 1 line dance and Heel and Toe Polka.

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of March students are working on creating a collage using colors, shapes and textures

Social Emotional Learning Curriculum - Sanford Harmony

This month we will be focusing on Empathy and Critical Thinking Skills. The students will learn to facilitate an awareness between thoughts, feelings, and behaviors. They will learn to promote empathy and incremental thinking and to reduce stereotyped thinking. Students will engage in interactive exercises and games to become aware of how their thoughts influence their feelings and behaviors, to learn the skills associated with empathetic responding, to recognize the malleability of human traits and abilities, and to identify the consequences associated with stereotyped thinking.
