# WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

#### Literacy:

We will be beginning our "Overcoming Obstacles Unit." Students will be reading Number the Stars in class and will be writing their own personal narrative on overcoming an obstacle or challenge. We will be focusing on content vocabulary and deeper character analysis. Our writing will focus on developing our story using dialogue and story mapping skills.

#### Math:

Students will begin working on Unit 9 of the Go Math curriculum. This unit focuses on decimal notation, reading and writing of decimals, comparing and contrasting the value of decimals and recognizing the correlation of decimals and fractions. Later in the month students will continue their study of Unit 12 of Go Math. Students will be reviewing patterns within the Metric System/US Customary Units.

### Social Studies:

We will begin to discuss the challenges the colonists faced establishing their new country. The students will learn about the Constitution, the Bill of Rights and the branches of government.

## Science:

This month the students will continue practicing for the Science Statewide Exam, which will be administered next month. The topics they will be focusing on include energy, movement, electricity, magnets, and measurement.

## What's New in Music and Art?

Mr. Cintula: We are starting our journey of folk music around the world through our textbook series "The Music Connection" grade 4. We will be singing together and solo as well as sample percussion instruments and techniques on various songs. Ms. LaMorte: Students will learn graduation piece with beautiful singing and appropriate behavior.

Ms. Granatelli: During the month of May, students in Class 420 will begin their participation in the visual arts component of the performing arts drawing and painting their self-portraits.

## Technology:

During the month of May, your child will be focusing on both keyboarding and mouse skills, as well as proper use of the Internet. We will be using online tools and a Typing Software Program to help maximize these skills. Along the way, we will work on integrating their literacy and mathematical skills, ensuring that all our students maximize their learning with hands on opportunities to succeed. We will also be continuing to learn about Microsoft Word and how to find information about a topic using online resources.


## News/Information/Tips/Reminders
