#### Dear Prek Families,

We had an amazing PreK year and your child has learned so much! We are so proud of them and are excited to see their growth next year in Kindergarten! We are sending home a set of Summer assignments that will help your child continue to grow and learn and be prepared for Kindergarten. All work should be submitted to your child's Kindergarten teacher on the first day of school.

### Summer Reading:

- Studies show that children who are read to will do better in school. You should be reading to/with your child for 20 minutes each day. We have included a list of recommended books. (There are also links for the books online.) We encourage you to also read books you have at home. If you have a NYC Public Library card, you have access to ebooks online as well as physical books in the library.
- 2. Included in this packet are short stories. Read them with your child. Point under the words as you read. Review story elements: Who are the characters in the story, Where is the story taking place(setting), was there a problem in the story? How did they fix it? How do the characters feel?
- 3. Have your child pick 5 of their favorite books and do a reading response. Fill out your Reading Log sheet each time you read a book and let us know if you liked the book by coloring in the smiley face. Have your child draw a picture about their favorite part from the book and have them try to write/copy a sentence about it on the Reading Response Sheet.

<u>Skills:</u> Summer is a great time to review the foundational skills we have learned this past year that will help your child prepare for Kindergarten. Below are some of the skills in the different areas that you can practice with your child.

#### Literacy

- Letter and Letter-Sound Review using the Fundation Chant
- Reading/Recognizing Sight Words (see list attached)

#### Writing

- Writing your first and last name.
- Writing uppercase letters and lowercase letters, and numbers starting letter formation at the top.
  - \*\* We have attached a sheet that can serve as a guide for how to write the letters and numbers.
- Writing on a line.

#### Math

- Rote counting 0-20; counting objects 0-20
- Writing the numbers 0-20
- Representing numbers 0-20 with objects
- Recognizing and making patterns
- Counting using a 5 frame and 10 frame
- Identifying basic shapes

#### Fine Motor

- Holding your pencil using proper pencil grip
- Cutting lines and curves (using proper scissor grasp)
- Cutting basic shapes
- Putting on jackets and zipping/buttoning


