WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Reading

We will be reading the non- fiction books **Century** Farm 100 Years on a Family Farm by Cris Peterson and Then and Now Life at Home by Vicki Yates.

We will be looking at change and the concept of then and now. Readers will understand that asking questions enables a reader to gain information from a text. Readers will explore content to understand that there are similarities and differences between then and now using the skill of compare and contrast.

<u>Writing</u>

Writers will understand that pictures and words in a sequence help tell a story. We will be describing an event, tell the order in which it happened and tell a character reaction. We will continue to write short sentences to add to our writing. We will use a capital letter at the beginning of the sentence and a period at the end. Please encourage your children to use sight words in their sentences. Students should make sure their sentence matches what the picture portrays. When doing writing homework with your child, encourage them to stretch their words and write the sounds they hear. Continue labeling their pictures. Practice reading and writing sight words with your child. These words are important tools for the beginning reader.

<u>Math</u>

We will be working on Chapter 6. In this chapter students will understand subtraction as taking apart and taking from. Important vocabulary words in this chapter are minus and subtract. We will look at three different subtraction situations that involve action. They are result unknown, change unknown and start unknown.

<u>Ms. LaMorte:</u> Students will work with pitch matching, learn/secure 2 dances, continue learning winter piece with motions, learn 3 pieces and apply proper play of rhythm instruments, learn/apply 2 chords for stage presence cue, continue securing class song and America. **Ms. Granatelli:** During the month of January, art students are
