WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

Reading

This month we will be reading the stories, Are You My Mother?, by P.D. Eastman, Come Along Daisy, by Jane Simmons, A House for Hermit Crab, by Eric Carle and Make Way for Ducklings, by Robert McCloskey.

Readers will understand that asking questions enables a reader to gain information from a text. Readers will explore main characters and setting, retelling, problem and solution, and character feelings in each story. We will also be studying the big idea of animal homes and living together.

<u>Writing</u>

We will be working on the common core writing standards, "I can retell a story" and "I can add details to my writing by using pictures and words by labeling our pictures". When doing writing homework with your child, encourage them to listen for the first sound in a word and match the letter to the sound. This is the first step in labeling a picture. Practice reading and writing sight words with your child. These words are important tools for the beginning reader.

<u>Math</u>

We will be working on Chapter 2. This chapter compares numbers to 5. Important vocabulary words in this chapter are compare, greater, less and same number.

What's New in Music and Art?

Ms. LaMorte: Students will learn proper singing skills, pitch matching work, beat competency work, learn 4 new songs with motions, and learn proper use/play of rhythm instruments.

<u>Ms. Granatelli</u>: During the month of October, students begin with learning to draw and paint their self-portrait.
